Base Group 12A

12A will be holding a **Sixth Form non-uniform day** on **Wednesday 25th November** to raise money for their two chosen charities: Framework and Shelter.

Framework, a charity based across the Midlands, offer housing, employment and mental health support with the aim to provide 'better futures for everyone'. They support more than 18,000 people a year providing a network of interlinking services that have the potential to change and save people's lives. Shelter Lincolnshire help homeless people by offering support, advice and helping them get resources, such as clothes, food and shelter. The rates of homelessness are increasing, especially as people are losing jobs and money due to COVID-19, so there are even more people becoming homeless or needing their help.

They would like to collect **financial donations** to support their incredible work, as well as **collecting items** for those engaged with the services of Shelter, such as toiletries and non-perishable canned food. Sixth Form students can bring whatever they are able to give to the 'contact-free' collection zone at the front of D4 on the day.

Base Group 12B

12B will be running for your money! On **Thursday 26th November**, 12B will spend the WHOLE school day running laps of the field. They will take it in turns to cover as much ground as possible – running, walking and dancing their way around... whatever the weather brings! Their chosen charities are Lincolnshire Rape Crisis and Lincolnshire Action Trust. Lincolnshire Rape Crisis is a charity that support women and men who have been affected by any form of sexual violence in their life. They provide support and information and offer meetings to attend. They help people through their tough times and help them get through their experience. Lincolnshire Action Trust is a charity focused on the care, resettlement and rehabilitation of individuals involved in the criminal justice system and those at risk of offending, as well as the welfare of their families and dependants. They provide training opportunities and key life skills to individuals and provide the support necessary to continue their rehabilitation. They would like to collect **financial donations** to support their chosen charities which can be a one-off donation for their day of running or a sponsor-per-lap for an individual student. Sixth Form students can bring whatever they are able to give to the 'contact-free' collection bucket at the front of D4 on the day.
