“Professional Business Dress”

As role models for younger students and ambassadors for our Academy it is important that Sixth Form students reflect our professionalism, high aspirations and desire for excellence in all that they do. We endeavour for our students to be employable young adults and so encourage them to dress smartly so they are aptly prepared for the world of work.



These images and descriptions below are to help you adhere to the expectations of professional, business dress and are by no means exhaustive. We expect you to use your judgment and look to Sir William Robertson Academy staff for guidance about what is appropriate. Any concerns will be raised with individuals. We reserve the right to ask students to modify/change their dress if they do not meet the required expectations of professional business dress. The Head of Sixth Form’s decision is final.

Items of clothing that are considered acceptable:

- Smart trousers, chinos, skirts or similar.
- Formal collared shirts, smart blouses or tops. Blazers are recommended. Ties are recommended with shirts.
- Smart black, brown or dark coloured shoes. It is recommended that these are flat or low heeled for practicality.

Students should not wear denim or leather jackets, jeans, leggings, strappy tops, clothes with large logos, tracksuit bottoms, hoodies or trainers. Hair and nails should be in keeping with a formal workplace.
